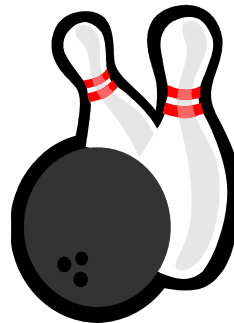

Thank you for your support in these areas. I see bright things in our future , your a terrific group.



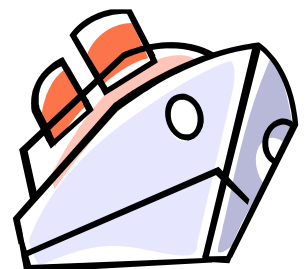
Tall Ships Trip July 7th - \$36.00 Reservations must be in by 6/14

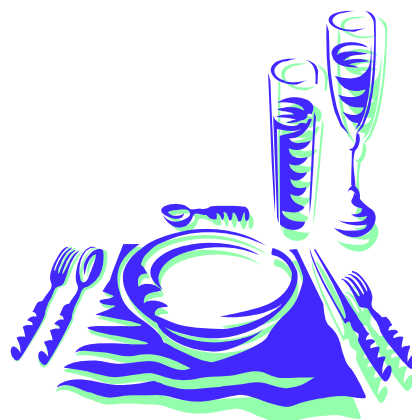
Lunch Bunch June 16, 1:00
